<b>-profen</b>	flurbiprofen; <b>ibuprofen</b> ; ketoprofen	NSAID
<b>-ridone</b>	paliperidone; <b>risperidone</b>	Antipsychotic
<b>-sartan</b>	candesartan; irbesartan; <b>losartan</b> ; olmesartan; <b>valsartan</b>	Angiotensin II receptor blocker, antihypertensive
<b>-semide</b>	<b>furosemide</b> ; torsemide	Loop diuretic, antihypertensive
<b>-setron</b>	granisetron; <b>ondansetron</b> ; palonosetron	Serotonin 5-HT3 receptor antagonist, anti-emetic
<b>-statin</b>	<b>atorvastatin</b> ; <b>lovastatin</b> ; pravastatin; <b>rosuvastatin</b> ; <b>simvastatin</b>	HMG-CoA reductase inhibitor, cholesterol lowering agent
<b>-tadine</b>	cyproheptadine; desloratadine; <b>loratadine</b> ; olopatadine	Histamine H-1 receptor antagonist, antihistamine
<b>-tadine</b>	amantadine; rimantadine	Anti-viral, Influenza A
<b>-terol</b>	<b>albuterol</b> ; <b>formoterol</b> ; levalbuterol; <b>salmeterol</b>	Beta-agonist, asthma treatment
<b>-thiazide</b>	chlorothiazide; <b>hydrochlorothiazide</b> ;	Thiazide diuretic, antihypertensive
<b>-tinib</b>	dasatinib; erlotinib; gefitinib; imatinib	Kinase inhibitor (chemotherapy)
<b>-trel</b>	<b>desogestrel</b> ; <b>etonogestrel</b> ; <b>levonorgestrel</b> ; norgestrel	Female hormone (progestin)
<b>-triptan</b>	eletriptan; <b>sumatriptan</b> ; zolmitriptan	Migraine treatment, 5HT1 agonist
<b>-tyline</b>	<b>amitriptyline</b> ; <b>nortriptyline</b>	Tricyclic antidepressant (TCA)
<b>-vir</b>	<b>acyclovir</b> ; famciclovir; <b>valacyclovir</b>	Anti-viral
<b>-vir</b>	<b>oseltamivir</b> ; zanamivir	Anti-viral, Influenza
<b>-vudine</b>	lamivudine; stavudine	Anti-viral
<b>-zepam</b>	<b>clonazepam</b> ; <b>diazepam</b> ; flurazepam; <b>lorazepam</b> ; <b>temazepam</b>	Benzodiazepine, sedative
<b>-zodone</b>	nefazodone, <b>trazodone</b> , vilazodone	Antidepressant

<b>-zolam</b>	alprazolam; midazolam; triazolam	Benzodiazepine, sedative
<b>-zosin</b>	alfuzosin; doxazosin; prazosin; terazosin	Alpha blocker

tretin-; tretin- -tretin	isotretinoin; tretinoic acid	Form of vitamin A, dermatology agent
vir; -vir	abacavir; efavirenz; ritonavir; tenofovir	Anti-viral
